## CHAPTER 2 DRIVERS OF FEED AND NUTRITION INSECURITY

## 2.8 Insecurity and conflicts

Insecurity has resulted in displacement of communities and loss of livelihood, contributing to nonsustainable resource utilisation. This has resulted in ineffective resource access and utilisation leading to risk of encroachment of invasive species which have depleted pastures, reduced their biomass yield and quality, and reduced their accessibility. This has led to overstocking in the secure areas where there is migration. There is also disruption due to conflicts leading to poor access to livestock markets and inputs.
