CHAPTER 4 STRATEGIC INTERVENTIONS TO ADDRESS RUMINANT FEED AND NUTRITION INSECURITY

4.2 Pillar 2: Feed access

Feed access to ruminants can be influenced by physical, social and economic factors. The following are the strategic interventions to address the challenges of feed access to ruminants:

4.2.1 Intervention 1. Enhance physical access to feeds

i. Establishment of road networks to improve on feed transportation and security

ii. Establishment of information and communication platforms for data and information sharing

- iii. Establishment of feed centres in remote areas where farmers can access adequate feeds
- iv. Improvement on feed contingency plans in case of disruption; and establish grazing plans
- v. Establishment strategic water infrastructure
- vi. Water trucking to enable use of idle pastures in the rangelands
- vii. Improvement of security to enable access to far flung areas
- viii. Establishment of conflict resolution mechanisms
